

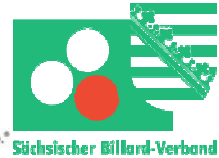

Accrediting: 15 minutes before the start of the set group phase. For all encounters, a waiting period of 5 minutes applies, which means that the game has to be started 5 minutes after the call, otherwise the encounter will be considered "lost to zero".

Dress: Sporty-tidy, that's:
 - one-coloured closed shoes
 - one-coloured long trousers
 - shirt or polo shirt with collar and sleeves (a club or association emblem does not need to be worn)
 - Ladies may alternatively wear a one-coloured long skirt

Referee: Respective opponents

Price Money: The received start-up money will be distributed as follows (with a lower number of participants less / with Added Money more):

1st place	600,00 EUR + trophy + Wildcard 2019
2nd place	350,00 EUR
2 x 3rd place	200,00 EUR each
4 x 5th place	120,00 EUR each
8 x 9th place	70,00 EUR each
16 x 17th place	35,00 EUR each
